- 6:00 AM Depart 7171 Allentown Blvd.
- 9:00 AM Arrive Battery Park—meet guide and board ferry to Ellis Island. Ellis Island, now a 27.5-acre site located just minutes off the southern tip of Manhattan Island, New York, is likely to connect with more of the American population than any other spot in the country. It has been estimated that nearly half of all Americans today can trace their family history to at least one person who passed through the Port of New York at Ellis Island. Now, nearly a century since the peak years of immigration, Ellis Island is one of the most popular tourist destinations in the National Park Service. Enjoy lunch on your own.
- 12:30 PM Return to Battery Park.
- 1:00 PM Depart on motorcoach for guided tour of Lower Manhattan to include Ground Zero viewing. Travel through the neighborhoods and piece together the different stories of immigration: from outsider tensions to economic prosperity of the growing Chinatown, shrinking Little Italy and vanished Irish Five Points.
- 5:00 PM End the tour at Grand Central Station and enjoy the unique food court for dinner before departing for home.
- 9:30 PM Approximate return to Elizabethtown
