DISCUSSION

Mr. McCahan addressed the Board regarding the following topics: (1) Parking sign enforcement on Bradford Blvd.- When ASAP gym is holding an event the overflow traffic is parking illegally on Bradford Blvd. which is in violation of the “no parking” signs. The State Police have stated that the enforcement of “no parking” regulations is the responsibility of the Township. Mr. McCahan is proposing that the Board of Supervisors establish a tow away zone in accordance with Section 187-38 of the Township code. There was general discussion regarding the problem. Mr. Hetrick offered to talk to the owner of ASAP to see if they can park at IFR to eliminate the parking problem. Mr. McCahan stated that if the Board establishes a tow away zone, that the fire police will volunteer to patrol the area and report any violators to be towed. It was the consensus of the Board to move forward with establishing a tow away zone on Bradford Blvd. (2) Manada Apartments- The PSAB is not completely satisfied with the proposed plan which doesn't provide a 26 foot access road that the PSAB believes is necessary. The current plan provides a 25 foot aisle way for the parking lot per township ordinance. The PSAB is concerned that the turn around for emergency vehicles will be very tight.

The PSAB offered to patrol at the “Movies in the Park” summer program.
