Discussion-Parks & Recreation Board: Pedestrian and Bicycle Path Project- Mrs. Schwartz addressed the board regarding the original pedestrian path engineering study which was completed in approximately 2002. The plan was very complex and costly. The Parks & Recreation board is suggesting the proposed project be smaller than the original plan and be completed in small phases.

Engineer Greg Schwartz reviewed the proposed project path and concept plan. The plan will utilize the existing pathways and streets for sections of the routes. He explained that phased development of routes will provide the greatest benefit at the lowest cost with the initial phases.

There was a brief discussion of project cost and what types of material would be used for the road surface. Mrs. Zimmerman commented that the Parks and Recreation board should thoroughly review the proposed project and bring back suggestions to the board of supervisors.

Mr. Holt stated that parks and recreation board is looking for feedback from the board of supervisors regarding moving forward with the project. It was the consensus of the board to move forward on the project in small phases.

Funding of the proposed project was discussed, Mrs. Zimmerman suggested that the township apply for funding from grant programs.
