A permit is required for use of the Compost Facility. They may be purchased at the Township Office, 7171 Allentown Blvd., Monday - Friday from 8 AM to 3:45 PM.

- **Season Pass:** \$30, \$5 additional within the same household (limit 2 passes per household)
- **1-day pass:** \$10, surrendered at day of use.

All information on stickers must match with vehicle in order to unload. (Licenses, plate #'s, etc.) The Compost facility is **self-serve**. You must be able to unload and/or load materials yourself. Unauthorized dumping will result in the revocation of your permit and loss of the privilege to use the Compost Facility.

<u>Compostable Material Accepted:</u>	<u>Unacceptable Compost Material:</u>
Leaves	Stumps, grass clippings
Weeds	Landscaping timbers, treated lumber
Branches; less than 6" diameter, not longer than 4'	Garbage, railroad ties, concrete
Yard waste	No construction waste
	No contractors permitted/ residents only

Recyclable Materials Accepted: (no permit required) Oil, CFL bulbs, Electronics

Material available for pick up: (free to residents): composted soil, wood chip mulch
