NEW TOPICS

Water & Sewer Authority-Sewer Expansion for Houck Manor and Holiday Park- Mr. Shope presented a recommended expansion alternatives summary sheet to the board for their review. He began the discussion with the options for Houck Manor. There are three options that were reviewed that would meet the needs/requirements of the Township's Act 537 plan. A low pressure sewer option is what is recommended by the Water & Sewer Authority with a base cost of \$912,000.00. The base option would discharge to a man hole at Winslett. There was discussion that the sewer line should be expanded to homes and businesses on Route 39 west of Walnut Avenue. The costs for the three options were reviewed and discussed. Mrs. Zimmerman suggested that a public forum be held for the residents to explain the sewer expansion.

Mr. Harman moved, seconded by Mr. Kurtz to approve the low pressure sewer system for Houck Manor. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Harman moved, seconded by Mr. Kurtz to approve the low pressure expansion on Linglestown Road west of Walnut Avenue to Piketown Road. Motion passed unanimously.

The expansion alternative for Holiday Park recommended by the Water & Sewer Authority is a gravity sewer system and pump station. The force main would run the entire length of Pinecrest Avenue, discharging at Winslett. The base cost for the project is \$1,363,000.00. A second option was presented that would include a gravity sewer system expansion to Moyer Road. There was brief discussion and it was decided that the proposed expansion to Moyer Road would be discussed at the public forum.

Mr. Kurtz moved, seconded by Mr. Harman to approve the base option gravity system for Holiday Park with a new pumping station with discharge to Winslett. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Kurtz moved, seconded by Mr. Harman to approve public forums to review/discuss sewer expansion for Houck Manor and Holiday Park. Motion passed unanimously.
