West Hanover Township Compost Facility 402 North Fairville Ave. (Public Works Shop)

Dates of Operation:

March 28, 2020 through November 28, 2020

Hours: Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday, 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM

A permit is required for use of the Compost Facility. They may be purchased at the Compost Facility or the Township Office, 7171 Allentown Blvd., Monday - Friday from 8 AM to 3:45 PM.

- **Season Pass:** \$30, \$5 additional within the same household (limit 2 passes per household)
- **1-day pass:** \$10, surrendered on day of use.

All information on stickers must match with vehicle in order to unload. (Licenses, plate #'s, etc.) The Compost facility is **self-serve**. You must be able to unload and/or load materials yourself. Unauthorized dumping will result in the revocation of your permit and loss of the privilege to use the Compost Facility.

***Please Note: used oil and antifreeze – 2-gallon limit per visit (free of water and gas)**

Material available for pick up: (free to residents): composted soil, wood chip mulch
