**Resolution 2020-54**

**RESOLUTION** by the Board of Supervisors of West Hanover Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania establishing the real estate tax levy rates for calendar year 2021, which shall take effective on January 1, 2021.

**BE IT RESOLVED** that a tax shall be and is hereby levied on all real property within the Township subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2021 and effective January 1, 2021 for the following purposes as follows:

- Tax rate for **General Purposes**, the sum of 0.9149 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of \$0 .09149 cents on each one hundred (\$100) dollars of assessed valuation.
- For **Fire Protection Purposes**, the sum of 0.3385 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation or the sum of \$0.03385 cents on each one hundred (\$100) dollars of assessed valuation.
- For **Fire Hydrant Fund**, the sum of 0.0720 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of \$0.00720 cents on each one hundred dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation. The same being summarized in tabular form as follows:

<b>TOTAL RE Tax Millage Rate</b>	1.3254 Mills	\$0.13254 Cents
