

**WEST HANOVER TOWNSHIP
DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

RESOLUTION 2020-37

WHEREAS, The Final Subdivision Plan & land Development Plan of Brookview-Phase 3 located in West Hanover Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania have dedicated to public use Right-of-Way (AKA) at a point of the eastern dedicated right-or-way along Fort Stewart Drive, at the dividing line of Lot 29 and lot 13 and northeast corner of Fort Stewart Drive and Barnett Circle.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of West Hanover Township, has approved the Final Plan of Brookview-Phase 3, which was recorded as Instrument No. 20120010241 in the Dauphin County Recorder of Deeds office and by such approval permitted the dedication of the said right-of-way pursuant to Section 1140.1 of the Second Class Township Code, Act of May 1, 1933 (P.L. 103, No. 69) now Section 231 (b) as reenacted and amended November 9, 1995 (P.L. 350, No. 60), as amended; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid roads, have been opened upon the ground, graded, stoned and macadamed, and the streets are being used by the general public;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Hanover, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, that the Board of Supervisors hereby accent Brookview Phase - 3 (AKA) Fort Stewart Drive (up to lots 29 and Lot 13) at the northeast corner of Fort Stewart Drive and Barnett Circle as public roads, and that said roads do hereby become part of the public road system of West Hanover Township. The public roads, which are made part of the public road system of West Hanover Township, are more particularly described as set forth hereinafter by the legal description and a plan, attached hereto, incorporated herein, and made a part hereby by reference thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Solicitor file one copy of the within Resolution together with the Exhibit, showing the location and width thereof, in the office of the Clerk of the Dauphin County Court of Common Pleas, Quarter Sessions Division, and a second copy certified by the Clerk of Courts be mailed to the Department of Transportation, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
